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Abstract

Diagnosis and therapy of rare lymphatic malformations

Rare lymphatic malformations (LMs), generalized lymphatic anomaly (GLA), Gorham–Stout disease (GSD) and Kaposiform lymphangiomatosis (KLA) are classified according to their pathology; however, some disease forms with differing pathologies are not separately defined entities. Because clinical findings overlap, and disease etiology, management, outcomes, and sequelae are unclear, they are difficult to diagnose. I would like to present recent studies about rare LMs and discuss clinical characteristics, diagnosis, treatment, genetics and further research.

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
