Dear colleagues and friends of lymphology,

I am delighted to invite you to Zurich for the 3rd Swiss Lymphology Symposium.

While lymphoedema is not a medical specialism in its own right, it is not uncommon either and can often be encountered in a wide range of medical disciplines, assuming that we doctors actually think of it and interpret the clinical signs correctly. This particularly applies to secondary lymphoedema, which is often a lifelong sequela following curative cancer treatments, for example. We are looking to gain some insight from surgical specialists as to why and where lymph nodes have to be removed during cancer therapy. This should improve our understanding in cases where lymphoedema does eventually come into play, and help us to explain the facts in a way that the patient can readily understand. In addition, both current and potential future approaches to treatment will be addressed. Other topics include the possibilities of imaging in lymphology, as well as the status of drug therapy, complex wounds and the indication for inpatient decongestive therapy.

Each talk will allow ample time for individual questions and discussions afterwards.

This series of talks is aimed at doctors from a wide range of specialisms who are interested in lymphology. Events of this type also provide an opportunity for networking, whether with therapists or professionals from the medical retail sector.
